Meaning: Paul said the Thessalonians incarnated the Word
Big Idea: We must flesh out the Word of God
Objective: I want the hearers to flesh out the Word of God
Theme:

According to the National Association of Unclaimed Property Administrators it is a real possibility that you have unclaimed assets being held by the government. About 1 in 7 people — 33 million altogether — collectively have an estimated \$70 billion worth of unclaimed property being held by state treasurers,.

The types of assets that end up with states range from uncashed <u>paychecks</u> or rebate checks to inactive <u>brokerage</u> <u>accounts</u> and unpaid <u>life insurance</u> benefits. The state of Tennessee has 1.2 billion dollars in unclaimed property by itself. The average value of each claim is \$2,080, according to the group. Last year, about \$4 billion in property was returned to rightful owners.

Each year on Feb. 1, the group holds "Unclaimed Property Day," when it encourages people to check missingmoney.com — a national clearinghouse for unclaimed assets that most states participate in — or an individual state's unclaimed property website.

THE SAME IS TRUE FOR MANY CHRISTIANS WHEN IT COMES TO SPIRITUAL ASSETS. IN CHRIST WE HAVE AN INCREDIBLE INHERITANCE THAT IS OURS TO CLAIM NOW – PEACE, JOY, POWER, WISDOM, COMFORT. HOW DO WE GET IT? BY GETTING IN THE WORD OF GOD!

BY DAILY READING GOD'S WORD AND APPLYING IT TO YOUR LIFE YOU GROW IN CHRIST AND CLAIM WHAT IS RIGHTFULLY YOURS IN CHRIST! **IT'S BEEN SAID** - A Bible that is falling apart is indicative of a life that is not.

Child of God – WE DON'T NEED LESS WORD IN OUR LIFE IN THESE CRAZY DAYS WE ARE LIVING IN – WE NEED MORE OF THE WORD! WE NEED MORE SERMONS, MORE BIBLE STUDY, MORE BIBLE PODCASTS. WE NEED MORE JESUS AND MORE CHURCH IN THESE DAYS NOT LESS!

READ 1 THESSALONIANS 2:13-16

How do you claim what is yours in the gospel?

RECEIVE THE WORD OF GOD

Receive here means to take to oneself or to fully embrace. It and the word accepted have a very similar meaning. So, the Christians at Thessalonica didn't just hear a sermon and go home. They didn't just listen to a 5 minute drive by devotional every now and again. THEY FULLY DEVOTED THEMSELVES TO THE WORD OF GOD AND GRABBED HOLD OF IT FOR THEMSELVES.

AS <u>Supernatural</u>

They received it for what it really is – THE WORD OF GOD! Church – the Bible is GOD'S WORD!

2 Timothy 3:16

That's what God's Word is for – it shows us God's best for life. Jesus didn't nullify the law when he died on the cross – he fulfilled it. He is the one who gives us life – and it is His Spirit that gives us the desire and the ability to obey that law.

2 REQUIREMENTS FOR BEING A REAL MAN: 1. You don't rely upon instructions to put things together 2. You don't rely solely on your GPS to get to your destination

The other day Chrystal and I were traveling somewhere and there was a backup on the interstate so I decided to take another way around. The GPS kept telling me to go one way but I kept going a different way around. Needless to say we got a little off track. God has given us His GPS – God's Plan for Success – it is right here in the Bible. When we fail to read and follow it we end up at the wrong destination.

THEY DIDN'T JUST GET IN THE WORD – THEY GOT IN THE WORD TO GET A WORD! They didn't get in the Word to get smarter – they got in the Word to WALK STRAIGHTER.

THE WORD OF GOD IS MEANT TO BE APPRECIATED AND APPLIED NOT MERELY READ

That's what Paul says here at the believers. He says they heard the Word and they received and accepted the Word, and that it was at work in them.

HOW DO YOU HAVE A TRANSFORMATIVE EXPERIENCE WITH THE BIBLE?

Romans 12 tells us not to be conformed to this world but to be transformed by the renewing of our mind to God's truth. God's Word is living and active and it has power. The goal of Bible study is a changed life not more knowledge.

2 Timothy 3:7 – Difficult times will come, people will be narcissistic and sinful – some will have the appearance of godliness but they will deny it's power.....Always learning and never able to arrive at a knowledge of the truth.

<mark>Open in Prayer</mark>

The Scriptures are not enough in and of themselves if we don't allow the Holy Spirit of God to speak to our hearts and convict us.

John 16:13

When the Spirit of truth comes, he will guide you into all the truth, for he will not speak on his own authority, but whatever he hears he will speak, and he will declare to you the things that are to come.
